

# What is Campus **Revolution**?

Campus Revolution is a **movement/mobilization** of young people who desire to **maximize** their time in colleges and universities by making a stand for their faith and to bring about **positive change (Revolution!)** in their campuses.

- It is a coming together of like-minded and like-spirited individuals who believe that it's **“biblical to be radical”**.
- It is about students being **unashamed** of the gospel and living a transparent life that showcases their faith for all to see.
- It's about young people bringing their friends to Christ, by making Christ's love **tangible** on campus.



## How to start a Campus Revolution:

You can start a revolution on campus by revitalizing the concept of prayer groups. How?

- By starting prayer groups with a purpose and on purpose. Students coming together to pray on campus is neither something new nor something outdated. But without a clear goal and purpose, it can turn into a ritual. We shouldn't just go about praying because we think it's the Christian thing to do.
- Worst still, we can end up praying about everything underneath the sky, thinking we've accomplished a lot but in actuality we're missing the mark God has set. Another unfortunate but common occurrence is for prayer groups to mushroom on campus but wither out as assignments, exams, tutorials and other extra-curricular activities kick in.
- This happens because there is a lack of conviction that prayer really works; a lack of courage to stand up (out) for God and a lack of commitment to keep it going.

Have a plan every time you meet up to pray. In CampusRevo, we believe that you don't need to pray long prayers using big words. You just need to target your prayers and pray your targets.

*You can do this by following our three step approach on the next page.*

**Step 1: *Strengthen Yourself in Prayer***

Start the prayer group off by praying for everyone gathered. We all have needs (exams, personal walk, etc). So it is completely alright — in fact essential that you cover one another in prayer.

This can usually be done by asking the group for personal prayer requests, followed by everyone praying for the person on their right (for example). Pray strong and believe that Jesus is who He says He is (God) and He can do what He says He can do (making the impossible, possible).



**Step 2: *Have an Outward Looking Faith***

After 'Step 1', get everyone to take the next five minutes praying for your unsaved classmates or course-mates.

Because this is a campus prayer group, we need to target our prayers at our unsaved friends who God has placed around us. Name them, pray for them and prophesy by faith for their salvation.

Another thing you are encouraged to do is intercede for your campus and ask God to open their spiritual eyes, spiritual ears and soften the hearts of your friends.

***Ephesians 6:12** says, "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."*

### Step 3: Faith + Action = Life

Campus Revolutionaries must not only be known for their faith but also their actions. Dare to do something radical for God!

End the prayer time by getting everyone in your group to seek the Holy Spirit for the next five minutes on what HE wants you to do that week. It could be an act of kindness or even evangelism opportunity.

Ask God for specific instructions and then spend the next 5 minutes listening. After that, share with the entire group and encourage each other to get moving and doing what God has placed in their hearts!

Remember! Our God is a miracle working God!
